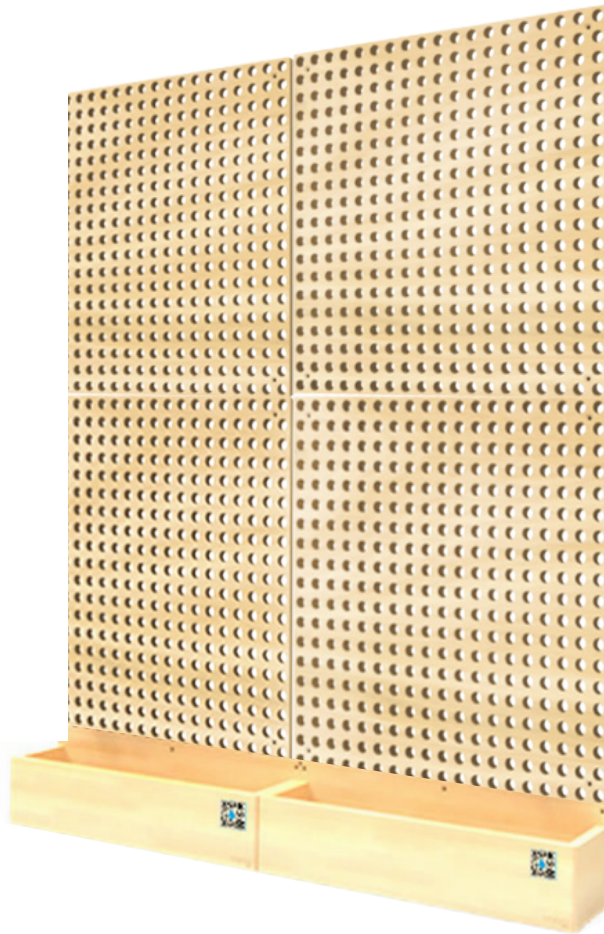
# Introduction

---

The Kidworx System is easy to install and consists of grid panels and storage bins designed to mount on your wall.

This guide provides step-by-step instructions for the installation of (4) grid panels in a 2x2 orientation, with (2) storage bins positioned below.

If you have more panels or wish to arrange them differently, you're welcome to do so. Just follow these installation instructions while orienting them to your preferred setup.

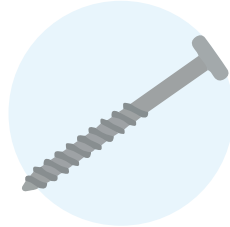

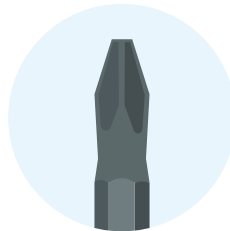

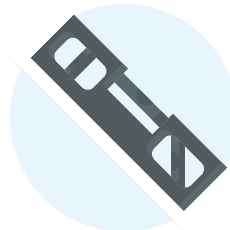

# Installation Steps

## 1 FINALIZE LOCATION

Determine where you mount your Kidworx System and ensure that you have adequate space for your chosen configuration. For a 2x2 grid with storage bins below, you'll need a space that's a minimum of 43" (109.2cm) tall by 38" (96.5cm) wide.

## 2 DRAW A LEVEL LINE ON THE WALL

Before installing the panels, it's important to ensure they are level and evenly aligned. Position a level against the wall where the top edge of the panels will be placed. Draw a horizontal line to serve as a guide for aligning the panels during installation.

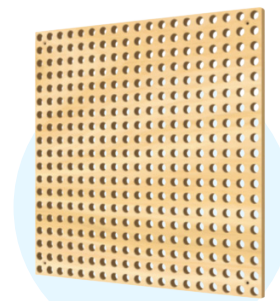
## 3 MARK THE CORNER HOLES FOR THE FIRST PANEL

Place your first grid panel in Position 1 (upper left) against the wall at the marked location. Double check that it is level. Use a pencil to mark the 4 small corner holes. Remove the grid panel from the wall.

## 4 INSTALL WALL ANCHORS

Place the tip of the self-drilling anchor at the pencil mark and use your drill fitted with a phillips head to drill it into the drywall.

**Note: If one of the marked locations aligns with a wall stud, you do not need to install an anchor there, as you will screw directly into the stud.**



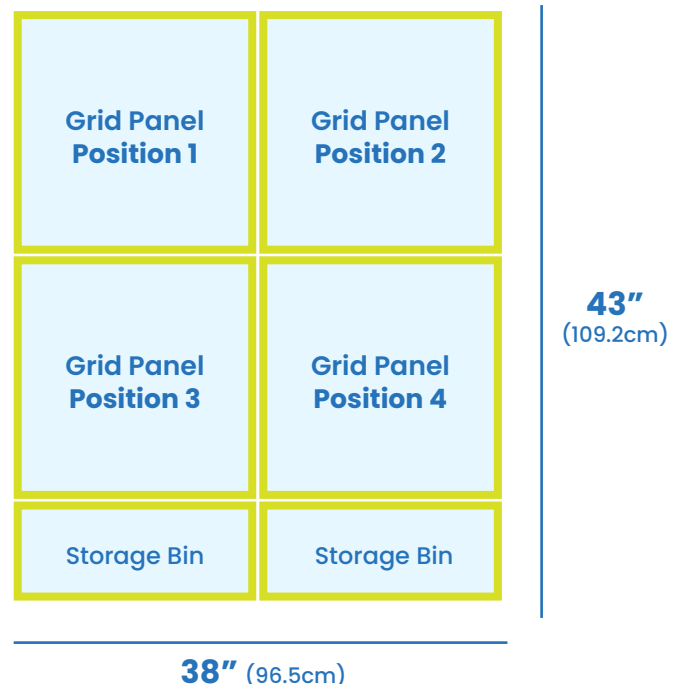
GRID PANEL

(48cm x 12.5cm x 12.5cm)



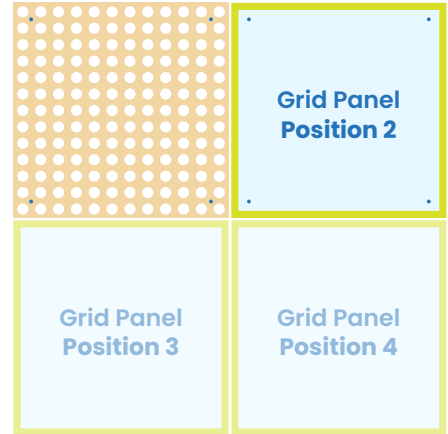
**5 INSTALL THE FIRST PANEL**

Place the grid panel back against the wall and secure it by screwing screws into each corner.



**6 MARK CORNER HOLES FOR PANEL 2**

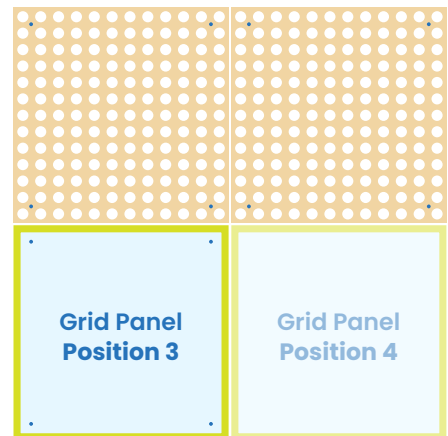
Place the second panel against the wall in Position 2 (upper right) making sure the 2 panels are touching each other and the top edge is aligned with the level line marked on the wall. Use a pencil to mark the 4 corner holes.



**7 REPEAT STEPS 4 and 5 to secure PANEL 2**

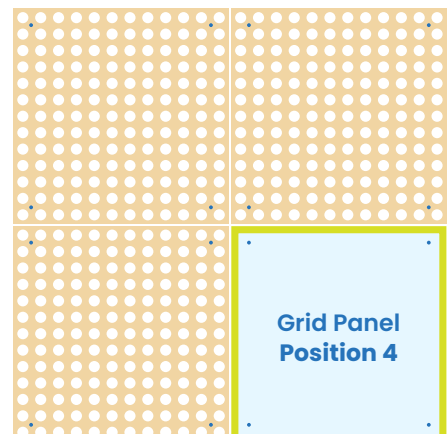
**8 MARK CORNER HOLES FOR PANEL 3**

Place the third panel against the wall in Position 3 (lower left) making sure the 2 panels are touching each other. Place a level vertically on the wall to ensure the left edge is lined up with the left edge of Panel 1. Use a pencil to mark the 4 corner holes.



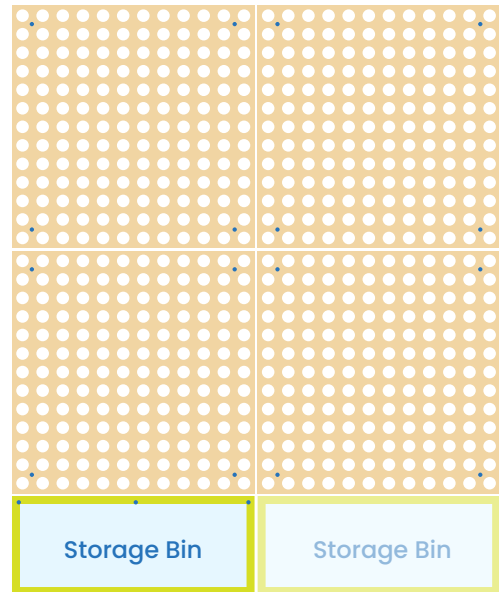
**9 REPEAT STEPS 4 and 5 to secure PANEL 3**

**10 REPEAT PREVIOUS STEPS to secure PANEL 4**



## 11 INSTALL THE LEFT STORAGE BIN

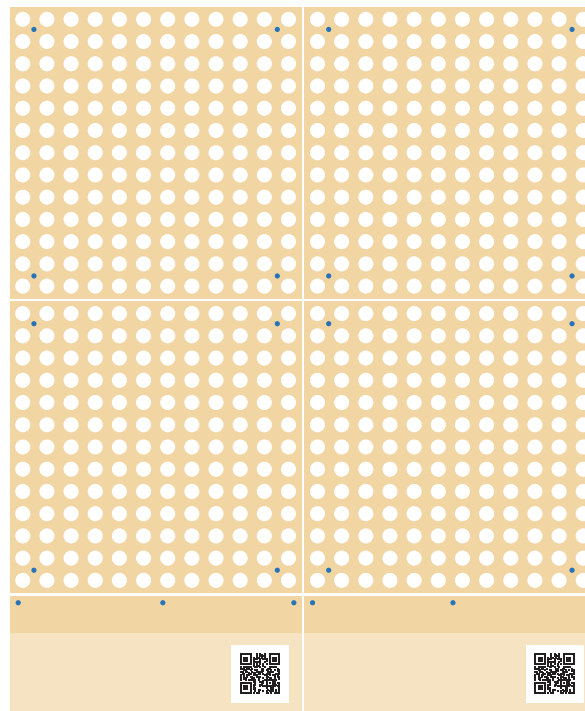
Place one of the storage bins below PANEL 3 making sure the top edge of the bin lines up with the bottom edge of the panel. Use a pencil to mark the (3) predrilled holes in the top edge of the bin. Follow the same anchoring and screwing process to secure the left storage bin in place.



## 12 INSTALL THE RIGHT STORAGE BIN

Repeat steps to finish the installation.

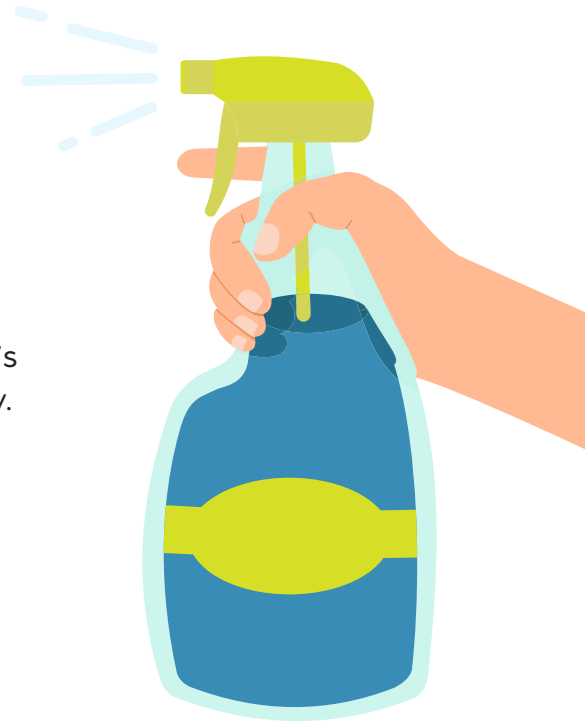

## Cleaning

---

Cleaning your Kidworx is easy. Simply use a 1:1 solution of water and distilled vinegar, or Mrs. Meyer's Clean Day spray and then wipe dry.



## Safety Guidelines

---

### Adult Supervision

Always have an adult or responsible guardian present while playing with Kidworx. They can provide guidance, assistance, and ensure safety throughout the creative process.

### Age-Appropriate Kits

Kidworx kits are designed for specific age groups. Make sure the kit you are using is suitable for the age and skill level of the child.

### Small Parts Warning

Some Kidworx kits may contain small parts that could pose a choking hazard. Keep these kits out of reach of children under the recommended age, and always monitor younger children closely.

### Embrace Trial & Error

Teach children that making mistakes and trying different approaches is part of the learning process. Encourage them to be patient, persistent, and open to experimenting with Kidworx kits.

### Cleanup & Storage

Keep the play area tidy and organized. Clean up any loose pieces, components, or materials after each session to prevent tripping hazards and to ensure Kidworx components are in good condition for future use. Store Kidworx components in a safe and organized manner when not in use. Keep them in a secure location away from younger children and pets.
